TEXT BOOK REUSE POLICY DOCUMENT

We at Venkateshwar Global School understand that conservation of natural resources is must for the ecological balance, sustainable development and eventually human existence. Saving paper means saving water, as it needs 324 liters of water to make 1 kg of paper!!

VGS has taken a number of initiatives in this direction, one being the development of 'Text-Book Reuse Policy'. A number of initiatives are taken under the policy, such as:

- Campaigns and workshops for sensitizing students and parents to understand the urgency for saving paper.
- Students and parents pledge together not to burn paper and recycle the same.
- Promotion of 'Paper Wise' strategies:
- 1. Use of textbooks as reading books.
- 2. Collection of the textbooks which cannot be reused for recycling at school.

- 3. Students are encouraged to interact with their seniors to borrow books from them after the final examinations are over.
- 4. The students are guided not to scribble in the books, wherever possible, so that the text books could be used by the next batch of students.
- 5. Students are encouraged to borrow reference books from the school library instead of purchasing the same individually.
- 6. Optimum use of technology is made for minimizing paper use. In order to ensure the same, students submit project reports and presentations online.
- 7. The school follows both sides printed notebooks for subjects such as Science and Geography too. A drawing sheet is used wherever required.
